We are a young, multi-disciplinary team that combines expertise in genetics, molecular biology, basic and clinical-translational research. We aim to *study mechanisms of oncogene addiction in Pancreatic ductal adenocarcinoma*, the deadliest type of cancer. We have funding from Instituto de Salud Carlos III (PI20/01267 and Miguel Servet Program), La Marató TV3 (167-C-2021 51) and Govern Illes Balears (AP21/041).

We are based in the IdISBa at Palma de Mallorca, Spain, which is an unusually great place to live and do science

The successful candidate will lead an open-ended project addressing fundamental questions in Oncogenes and Pancreatic cancer in a totally bench-to bedside approach with direct clinical applicability

For Postdoc positions we need

- PhD Biomedicine, Medicine, Biology, Pharmacy or similar (or evidence of completion in the near future)
- At least 1 first-author publication in Q1 Journals
- Candidates should have a strong background in Biomedical Research especially in Cancer Research
- Special preference will be given to candidates with prior experience in Pancreatic Cancer research or Patient-derived Organoid technology
- Good organizational skills and excellent attention to detail.

We offer: 35.000 €/yr for 2 years

For Predoc positions we need

- Min average mark above 8.0/10
- Master degree on Biomedicine, Medicine, Biology, or similar fields (or evidence of completion in the near future)
- Familiar with standard molecular techniques (such as cloning, PCR, qPCR, western blotting, etc...), Cell culture, Primary culture, FACS analysis, etc
- Good level in written and spoken English
